Invitation to Submit Proposals

SASSCAL invites proposals from qualified audit firms to conduct its annual financial, compliance and statutory audit for the financial year 2026. The appointment will be for an initial period of one (1) year, with SASSCAL retaining the option to extend the engagement, subject to satisfactory performance. The statutory audit will be conducted in accordance with the law of the jurisdiction in which the relevant SASSCAL entity is legally registered, in accordance member Countries legal requirements and SASSCAL's governance standards. The audit will cover funding from member states, BMFTR, and other donors, ensuring transparency and compliance with international financial reporting standards.
